

Hartford Law Campus LED Lighting Upgrade

UConn's Facilities Operations department completed a project installing new LED lighting across the UConn Hartford Law Campus in the summer of 2022. The new lighting provides significant enhancements towards our goal of becoming a Carbon Neutral Campus by 2030. This project was funded by our capital program coupled with our close partnership with Eversource Utilities. The lighting work consisted of LED upgrades to approximately 242,092 square feet of building area. Similar to recent LED upgrades at the Storrs Campus, many of these areas were also equipped with additional energy savings measures such as occupancy sensors and dimming controls.
